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MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 3RD, 2021, IN CLIVIGER VILLAGE HALL

1. Code of conduct (Declaration of Interest). Coun. Heys on planning.

2. Apologies for absence

3. Police report

Please see attached. PSCO M Hill has completed speed observations in Burnley Road and Red Lees Road and there were no issues, he is going to carry out further observations at different times. Coun Emo has put up the speed indicator device. The clerk to report tractors speeding through the village and to Long Causeway.

4. Questions from residents

Residents attended to discuss in more detail an idea for a community garden in the Holme Chapel Memorial Garden. Coun Emo is to sort out the weeds in Station Road and is getting a quote for the path pointing. The group is currently preparing an action plan and sorting out its constitution. Coun. Towneley is to prepare a legal agreement.

5. Minutes of the last meeting and matters arising

These were accepted

(a) New sign at Mereclough Memorial Garden

A quote of £1,100 to cut back the trees has been agreed and Coun Emo to organise work. Coun Towneley to sort out the return of the benches from the borough council parks department .

(b) Footbridge, Walk Mill

LCC's bridge inspector is to assess the bridge. The vegetation has been cut back.

(c) Mount Lane playing fields lease

Ongoing.

(d) Vegetation at Mount Lane to Meadow Top

Coun. Emo is to look at this.

(e) Fascia boards at Park Road pavilion

A joiner has been employed to repair.

(f) Vegetation from Hillcrest to Dyneley Avenue

LCC are to do a one off flail cut in the near future.

(g) Scottish Power Benefit Fund

The fund deadline has been extended until the end of the month. Coun Towneley to organise a bid for a wildflower project on 4 places on the A646, Red Lees Road junction with The Lees and at the Salterforth Lane/Red Lees Road junction with quotes from Burnley parks and a private firm. Coun Smith asked if the fund could be use to purchase average speed cameras similar to Blacko. The clerk to invite the Police and Crime Commissioner, highways cabinet member for LCC and Worsthorne Parish Council to the next meeting to discuss.

(h) Fencing near the garage

Coun. Towneley to investigate repairs and also to see if the banking nearby can be cleared.

(i) Trees growing onto Burnley Road

Worsthorne Estates has agreed to look at the problem of the vegetation growing onto the pavement from their land.

(j) Noticeboards

Coun. Emo is organising new noticeboards.

(k) Milestones

A heritage restorer has quoted £4,000 for the renovation of the milestones and boundary stones in the parish. This was agreed by the council.

(l) Miller Homes

Coun Emo to speak to Miller Homes re the state of the entrance and the verge opposite the development which has been damaged during building work

(m) Ceramic poppies

Coun Towneley is liaising with Rev Casey over the installation of the poppies in St John's following a request for this to be done in time for Remembrance Day.

One allotment holder has given up the plot and another plot has come up for vacancy and will be split into two plots once fencing and tree pruning have been done. Couns Whittle and Towneley to organise.
